CANINE PARTNER SPAY/NEUTER CERTIFICATION

If you are entering a dog registered with AKC as a Canine Partner (registration # beginning with MA or MB), one of the requirements is that you will provide an AKC spay/neuter certification from your vet.

AFTER ENTERING THE EVENT AND HAVING RECEIVED THE EMAILED INITIAL RECEIPT OF ENTRY, please use the link below to access an online website for uploading your dog's spay/neuter certification from your vet. Enter your dog's AKC Reg # (two letters followed by 8 numbers; no dashes, slashes or spaces) and your PIN # which is the last 4 of the telephone # on-file with AKC; include any leading zero(s). Send email to steve.herwig@akc.org if you are unsure what PIN # to use.

We must receive this verification by **Wednesday, September 16, 2026**; else, your entry will become invalid as your registration will be put into a referral status pending further investigation.

VIDEO ASSISTED REVIEW OF CONTACT CALLS

The use of video may be used for contact review during the Finals round. When used, all contact calls of a class, all heights, will be reviewed via a video frame-by-frame system by an AKC Field Representative on-site. All reviewed calls by the AKC Field Representative will stand as the final decision.



DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER - ENTER THIS EVENT ONLINE!

****NEW** This event is by invitation only.** The top 5 dogs of each breed (plus TWO (2) Top Preferred dogs, when applicable for the breed) are invited to attend.

If your dog is among the select few being honored with an invitation to compete at this prestigious event, you may enter online at www.akccompanionevents.com/agi then click on **Enter Event Online**.

TOP 15 POSTED LIST: The Top 15 list shall be published after all trial results are finalized through **June 30, 2026**. We estimate that list will be posted on/about **July 24, 2026**.

****NEW** INITIAL ROUND OF INVITES:** The Primary Owner of all dogs within the **Top 5 & Top Two Preferred Dogs (if applicable for that breed; see below)** shall be emailed an invite. We estimate these initial invites to be sent out the week of **July 27, 2026**. Exhibitors may request a paper invite be mailed by USPS by sending email to steve.herwig@akc.org

ENTRIES OPEN/CLOSE: Entries will open on **Monday, August 3, 2026 at 8:30 am EST**. There will be two entry time periods with Round 1 entries closing on **Monday, September 7, 2026 at 8:00 pm EST** and Round 2 entries closing on **Wednesday, September 16, 2026 at 11:59 pm EST**.

NOTIFICATION OF NOT ENTERING THE EVENT: In lieu of an opt-out option, exhibitors who wish to notify AKC that they are not going to enter the event may fill out the **Notification of Not Entering The Event** online form located at www.akccompanionevents.com/agi on/about **July 24, 2026**. This will allow us to invite the next dog on the list (see below).

ADDITIONAL INVITES AS OPENINGS ARISE: During the time period of **August 3, 2026 through Monday, August 31, 2026**, additional invitations will be emailed to the next dog in-line as openings arise from invited dogs within each breed notifying AKC they do not plan to enter/attend the event. Additional invites will not be sent out during Round 2. ****NEW** No Additional Invites will be sent after the Monday, August 31, 2026 additional invite deadline.**

****NEW** TOP 5 AND TOP TWO PREFERRED DOGS (when applicable for that breed) INVITES:** If the Top 5 dogs on a breed's invites list are all regular dogs, then additional invites to the top two Preferred dogs will also receive a Top Preferred invitation.

If there are less than five regular dogs, the Top Five will be filled out with Preferred Dogs; additional invites will not be sent.

If an opening arises because the Top Preferred invitee notifies AKC he/she is not entering, the additional invite will be sent to the next Preferred dog on the list.

If an opening arises because a Top 5 invitee notifies AKC he/she is not entering, the additional invite will be sent to the next dog on the list regardless if that dog is regular or preferred.

REGULAR & PREFERRED INVITES, SAME DOG: If an exhibitor's dog receives both a regular and preferred invite, please send email to steve.herwig@akc.org to clarify which invite you are accepting.

No entries will be accepted by fax, phone or hand delivery. It is the exhibitor's sole responsibility to assure their entry is received by the closing date and time.

Exhibitors may only submit entries using the Official AKC Agility Invitational Entry Form provided online. Please do not submit pre-filled out generic entry forms; your entry will not be accepted.

MEASURING & HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card may still compete; but they must be measured by an Agility Field Representative during exhibitor check-in.

Dogs may not jump lower or higher than their official Regular AKC jump height as listed below.

Dogs qualifying for this event from the Preferred classes will run at the Preferred jump height and will be scored within the Regular jump height at the regular course times listed in the DESCRIPTION & SCORING section later in this booklet. (Example: 4" Preferred dogs will be scored with 8" Regular dogs.) Only dogs that have qualified for this event from the Preferred classes have the option to jump at the Preferred jump heights as listed below.

Jump height divisions:

Preferred	Regular	
4 Inches	8 Inches:	For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
8 Inches	12 Inches:	For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
12 Inches	16 Inches:	For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
16 Inches	20 Inches:	For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
20 Inches	24 Inches:	For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.

EXHIBITOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (EXHIBITOR TEE-SHIRT SIZE, ANNOUNCER BIOS, CRATING REQUESTS)

All entrants will receive a free exhibitor's tee-shirt - unisex adult & children sizes available. One tee-shirt per dog entered. Your tee-shirt size must be submitted by **Wednesday, September 16, 2026**. A Large-adult tee-shirt will be provided by default to all exhibitors who do not provide their tee-shirt size by this deadline date.

To assist our announcer at the event, if you and/or your dog's name is spelled unusually, please spell them out phonetically to assist us with pronunciation using the field provided on the *Exhibitor Additional Information* web form.

The announcer will first read your dog's full registered name, then both owner and handler, followed by three speaking points which you may provide on the *Exhibitor Additional Information* web form. We cannot guarantee the announcer will read each dog's information, but we will attempt to make sure that all are recognized.

Announcer speaking points may be submitted online until **Wednesday, December 9, 2026 @ 5:00 p.m. EST**.

Exhibitors will also be able to update their own handler changes and announcer bios while at the show site using the computer workstations provided.

CRATING SPACES

Each **3 foot by 5 foot** crating spot will be identified by a unique identification number.

Because you have pre-reserved a crating space, you **DO NOT** have to arrive together.

Each exhibitor will be required to display an emergency contact information card on the outside of each crate; card(s) will be supplied labeling each crating space location.

The information card must have your name and emergency contact information (cell phone# or other).

No Ex-Pens will be allowed in crating area.

All dogs must be housed in a crate, which must have sides, a top, and a bottom, all parts being interconnected, thus preventing the dog from being able to escape the enclosure even if knocked over. The top and/or bottom of the "crate" may be not be secured only by Velcro or a Velcro-like product. There must be additional fasteners that will prevent both the top and bottom from coming off and will not allow the dog to escape the enclosure.

IMPORTANT – All exhibitors will select their dog's crating space location from an online system mapping which spaces are available between **November 2, 2026 @ 8am Pacific (11am Eastern) and November 9, 2026 @ 5pm Pacific (8pm Eastern)**. Those who wish to have crating spaces next to each other must select one crating group representative who will select all crating spaces within their group at the same time.

Any crating group representative that has 10 or more entered dogs to be housed within their group should submit the online Large Crating Group Coordinator Notification form prior to **October 25, 2026**, to be published online when ready at www.akc.org/agi

Crating coordinators with 10 or more in their group will be allowed early tiered access into the online system prior to general availability IF notice has been made prior to **October 25, 2026**.

If any exhibitor or group wishes to have their space(s) randomly assigned by AKC, send email to steve.herwig@akc.org. Spaces for a group will be side by side and/or across an isle from each other. No other special requests will be accommodated if AKC manually assigns the space(s).

Any entered dog whose owner has not selected a crating space by **November 9, 2026** will have a crating space assigned randomly from among those available.

An extra space request may be made by an AGI exhibitor for dog(s) competing elsewhere in the Convention Center during the Friday, December 11, 2026 thru Sunday, December 13, 2026 timeframe. Proof of entry will be required when making an extra space request. Extra spaces are limited; subject to availability. Only one (1) extra space max will be granted per AGI exhibitor no matter how many dogs are entered elsewhere in the Convention Center. Form will be published at www.akc.org/agi when ready.

AKC reserves the right at any time to use an alternative crating space assignment system different than the system mentioned above.

AKC AGILITY INVITATIONAL - DESCRIPTION & SCORING

The Agility Invitational will consist of **Round #1** JWW, **Round #2** STD, **Round #3** Hybrid (16-18 obstacles, two contacts), **Round #4** JWW, **Round #5** Finals (open only to top 57 dogs overall through 4 Rounds of competition). For the finals round only one dog from each breed within each jump height will be invited to participate in the finals.

AKC Agility Master rules will apply with the following exceptions:

- Course faults will be scored as follows: Refusal or Run-out = 5 points; Wrong Course = 5 points; Failure (e.g. missed contact or dropped bar) = 5 points; Elimination (obstacle not completed or skipped) = Whistle (score of zero); Course time deductions = 3-point deduction for every second over course time truncating down to whole numbers.
- All obstacles must be completed or a score of zero will be assessed.
- Fault limits may be imposed by the Event Committee based on entries. If a dog reaches the announced fault limit, the round would be scored as a zero.
- Obstacles required by class level may be altered for this event.
- Preferred dogs will run at their Preferred height but will be scored within their Regular height at the regular course times listed below. (e.g. 4" Preferred dogs will be scored with 8" Regular dogs.)
- All dogs entered will be required to jump at the AKC jump height based on the shoulder height of the dog. Any dogs without an official AKC jump height card, will be required to be measured during exhibitor check-in. Dogs may not jump lower or higher than their official AKC jump height.
- In case of a cumulative score/time tie, the dog with the highest score, then lowest run time from the Standard round will break the tie.
- JAC cumulative overall winners from each scored jump height (8,12,16,20,24) will be invited to compete in AGI. If a JAC entrant competes in the Finals round, an additional finals entrant will be added as if the JAC entrant was not included.
- If a Foreign Country entrant competes in the Finals round, an additional finals entrant will be added as if the Foreign Country entrant was not included.

ROUND 5 – FINALS

Dogs will be run in reverse order based on placements through 4 rounds of competition. This will be a Standard agility course and Finalists placements will be based on score, then time, from the Finals class only. Finalist placement runs must have received a time and score.

Exhibitors Take Note: To fit ESPN's broadcast in the available time slot, not all dogs will make the final televised version of the Agility Invitational Finals. All AGI rounds, including Finals, shall be made available for viewing at www.akc.tv

* Only dogs from **Top Dogs by Breed** invitations are eligible for **Top Score BBE, Top Clear Round, Top Dogs after 4 Rounds, and Top Dog Medallion after 4 Rounds for each Breed** awards. Foreign Country invite entrants are not eligible for special awards.

*** Junior Agility Competition (JAC) winners are only eligible for the **Top Junior from JAC** from the special awards.

Final Round Awards: All Finalists will receive a Finalist Ribbon. Placement rosettes and prizes will be awarded for each jump height as follows:

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles and jumps shall be used pursuant to the latest edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, however, obstacles required by class level may be altered for the event. All classes will take place indoors on a sports turf surface. There will be three 95' x 95' rings. Electronic timing and rubberized contacts will be used.

Anyone running more than one venue at this event, that has a ring conflict, MUST run during your dog's jump height.

Dogs may not be in the seating area around the rings, especially during the Finals round.

OFFICIALLY RECORDED TITLES

Titles used at this event for the catalog, announcer and awards shall be from what is officially recorded with AKC as of the following dates:

Titles recorded as of **Wednesday, September 16, 2026** will be listed in the catalog.

Titles recorded as of **Wednesday, December 9, 2026** will be made available to the announcer and used when determining award eligibility.

Exhibitors shall not need to provide title updates as we'll be using what titles are on their dog's official record for determining award eligibility.

FRIDAY TIME-2-BEAT TITLING CLASS

All AKC Agility Invitational exhibitors may enter the TIME-2-BEAT titling class with dogs that are entered in the 2026 Agility Invitational or 2026 Juniors Agility Competition. No other dogs are eligible for entry. This class will be timed, judged and scored using the current AKC regulations for T2B. **A Qualifying leg and Points may be earned during Friday's T2B run!**

For dogs to participate in this T2B class, exhibitors must complete the class selection on the entry form. The walk-thru and run times for T2B will be published in the posted Ring Schedules after Round 2's closing date.

If you entered your dog online and forgot to enter the T2B Class, please email steve.herwig@akc.org. Your additional entry to add T2B must be received by the closing date of **Wednesday, September 16, 2026**.

2025 YEAR-END TOP MACH & PACH DOGS

Year-End Top MACH & PACH Dogs for 2025 were calculated based on the calendar year January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025. The dog with the highest score of (2Q's x 10) + MACH/PACH points earned during this calendar year timeframe has earned the status of 2025 Top Dog for their breed.

This award is not calculated based on the eligibility period of the Agility Invitational (July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026), but rather the January-December 2025 calendar year, therefore, these dogs may not be the #1 ranked dogs invited to the 2026 Agility Invitational to compete. You can check to see if your dog was #1 for 2025 by going to <http://www.akc.org/events/agility/statistics/>

Year-End Top Dog notifications will be emailed to the primary owner on-record **after Wednesday, September 16, 2026.**

Year-End Top MACH & PACH Dogs for 2025 will be invited to submit/upload online a picture of their dog. All slides will be made available for online viewing both at and after the event.

These picture submittals are for the **Year-End Top MACH & PACH Dogs for 2025**; which is not necessarily the same dogs sent an invite to enter the 2026 Agility Invitational (see above).

The deadline for submitting these pictures is **Wednesday, November 25, 2026**. NO picture submittals or slideshow changes will be accepted after this deadline! This deadline is absolute.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

DOGS PARTICIPATING. This event is by invitation only. The Top 5 dogs (and 2 Top Preferred dogs when applicable) of each breed are invited to attend. Dogs must meet the minimum entry requirements in order to participate at this event and must also meet the eligibility requirements specified in the Regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

DUE TO LIMITED SPACE, no ex-pens will be allowed in the facility. Each entered dog in the Agility Invitational will receive one assigned crating space. There may be a limited number of extra spaces for dogs not entered.

NOTHING WITH WHEELS may be ridden by an exhibitor inside the Convention Center except for the scooters rented by the facility and ADA-approved devices.

ENTRY FORMS: No phone, fax, or hand-delivered entries will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of Event Committee or a duplicate entry for the same dog. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ENTRY FEES FOR BITCHES IN SEASON will be refunded if the Trial Secretary is notified in writing at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on **Saturday, December 12, 2026**. Vet statements should be provided to the Trial Secretary in writing to receive a refund. After **December 12, 2026**, entry fees will not be refunded for bitches in season. Refunds will be issued within 60-90 days of the request.

ENTRY FEE REFUNDS DUE TO INJURY/ILLNESS: AKC offers a one-half refund of entry fees after the closing date if either dog or handler become injured or ill. Written notice must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than when the first dog begins to run during the event weekend.

T2B CLASS – A T2B titling class will be held on **Friday, December 11, 2026**. All dogs entered in the AKC Agility Invitational and Juniors Agility Competition are eligible to enter this class. In order to participate, check the T2B class selection on the entry form provided with the invitation.

CANCELLATION NOTICES of entries must be received by **Wednesday, September 16, 2026 @ 8:00 p.m. EST**. Refunds will be issued within 60-90 days of the request. **No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

ON-LEASH. Dogs must be on leash at all times on event grounds except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

CLEAN UP. Please pick up after dogs at show site and hotels. Dogs must use the designated exercise areas.

RINGSIDE. Judges are not required to wait for dogs! The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY. The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. LEADS. Dogs may not be on retractable leads or long-lines while inside the buildings at the Orange County Convention Center
